- Operate vinyl cutters and other production equipment (training provided)
- Learn to operate a CO₂ laser and other fabrication equipment
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized work environment
- Assist with fabrication, production, and installation tasks as directed by management

Requirements:

- Dependable, punctual, and motivated to learn with strong work ethics and positive attitude
- Reliable transportation and/or a driver's license
- Excellent attention to detail
- Comfortable performing hands-on work throughout the day, using computers and learning new software
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
